# SEVENTH SUNDAY OF EASTER

## FROM THE PASTOR

**"NOW GLAD OF HEART BE EV'RY ONE! THE FIGHT IS FOUGHT, THE DAY IS WON,  
THE CHRIST IS SET UPON THE THRONE. WHO ON THE ROOF WAS CRUCIFIED,  
WHO ROSE AGAIN, AS AT THIS TIDE, IN GLORY TO THE FATHER'S SIDE..."**

An Easter Sourcebook: The Fifty Days, p. 115

Jesus' mission was to bring the Good News of the Father's love to the people he met along the way. This was especially true with the apostles. He needed time to form them before revealing the secrets of his heart. He taught them by what he said and by what he did. Unfortunately, it took longer than Jesus may have expected. All of this certainly took longer than even we had expected. Even though we may have wanted this to happen yesterday with the apostles, for us, it may take as long if not longer to grasp the impact and meaning of who Jesus is and what he said and did.

It is very easy for us to think that because we believe in Jesus and have done so for any number of years, then we should understand the impact of his presence better than the apostles did. Like the apostles, though, it takes time for us to come to understand the impact that Jesus has on our lives. We, too, have to listen to the message, be formed by it and then begin to reflect it in our lives. Hopefully, this Season of Mystagoga has helped us in this period of formation.

The death and resurrection of Jesus has changed not just our lives but the world. This time has given us a different way to experience life, to discover the wonder that Jesus is for us and the challenges he places before us as a people that he has formed by his Word and Sacrament. As we come closer to the end of the Easter Season, hopefully we have come to see our lives and the lives of others differently and the responsibility we have to be a sign of the new life, hope and resurrection he has given to us.

The final total for our Easter Collection is **\$39,657**. While this is less than our budgeted total, I am grateful to all of you for your continued support and generosity to our parish. You are the reasons why I can always say how proud and privileged I am to serve you as your pastor.

On behalf of our entire Parish Staff, and myself, I want to extend to all **MOTHERS, GRANDMOTHERS, GOD MOTHERS, STEP MOTHERS, FOSTER MOTHERS AND AUNTS**, our best wishes for a **HAPPY & BLESSED MOTHER'S DAY!!** May this be only one day out of 365 days that we recognize the gifts that mothers are to all of us.

- \* A 2013 study examining the levels of lawn pesticides in the urine of dogs found that herbicides persisted on lawn surfaces for at least 48 hours after spraying.
