PASTOR'S COLUMN



Reflection on the Readings

Consider the scene from this Sunday's gospel. Peter has just made his great confession, which has earned him the keys to the Kingdom. All the disciples had recognized Jesus as "truly the Son of God!" after he stilled the storm at sea. Wouldn't you think this is a choice moment in which to reveal the coming hour of Passion? And you would be wrong. No sooner does Jesus predict what's on the horizon than Peter sees fit to dress him down for it. Peter's operating out of loyalty here, of course. He will

not see Jesus humiliated or defeated. He cannot conceive of harm coming to the leader he loves and reveres.

But Peter is also making a mistake. He's thinking in simple, mortal terms of how success and failure are measured. He would much prefer that Jesus would gain the whole world rather than lose his life. And we all think this way, both in the church and outside it. We want our parishes to grow and expand in size, wealth, and popularity. We want to be liked, applauded, and appreciated. We want others to agree with us and support us. We don't want adversity. We avoid, at all costs, the cross.

Friends, Jesus calls this attitude "Satan," the name of the great adversary whose name means exactly that, "to oppose, obstruct." It is an adversarial spirit to the mind of God. When we hope for tangible, material signs of success, we are setting up a rival to God in our hearts. Peter had no idea how close to the precipice he stood on the day Jesus sharply drew him back.




Saint James Memorial & Honor Butterfly Release

Family Faith Formation Registration is Open for 2023-2024!

2023-2024 Family Faith Formation sessions will begin on Sunday, September 17 after the 8AM, 10AM and 12 noon masses. Confirmation sessions will begin with a parent and child meeting on Tuesday, October 3rd (for 7th grade) and on Tuesday, October 17th (for 8th grade) at 7PM in the Church.

If you have not registered your child yet, please know it needs to be done before September 15th for children in grades 1st to 6th and before September 30th for children in the Confirmation preparation process (7th and 8th grades). The registration form and the calendar dates for both, the Family Faith Formation sessions for 1st to 6th graders, and the Confirmation sessions for 7th and 8th graders can be found on the Family Faith Formation page of the parish website, https://saintjamestheapostle.org/. Any registration received after August 31st will incur a \$50 increase.

The parent meeting for families who are new to the Family Faith Formation program will take place on **Monday, September 11 at 7PM in the Church** and the meeting for parents of children who will be receiving the Sacraments of Reconciliation and First Holy Eucharist this 2023-2024 year is on **Monday, September 11 at 8PM in the Church**.
